## 2022 Guidelines

Application deadline: All materials are due **Monday, June 13, 2022**. Awards will be announced by August 2022.

Award: \$500 prize

Eligibility: Ph.D. awarded by a University of Miami Humanities Department in 2021-22 (December 2021 or May 2022). Note that August 2021 graduates can also be considered.

Requirements: Please submit the following to <u>humanities@miami.edu</u>.

- 1. <u>letter of nomination</u> (typically written by the dissertation adviser/director)
- 2. along with an electronic <u>copy of the entire dissertation</u>
- 3. a file with the introduction
- 4. and a final <u>file with the abstract</u>.

The awardee will be requested to deposit a bound copy of the dissertation at the Center for the Humanities.

Criteria: 1. Dissertation has a wide, interdisciplinary, humanistic appeal.

- 2. Dissertation is well written (i.e., avoids jargon or, if it uses specialized language, it carefully explains all terms used).
- 3. Introduction is well organized and solidly argued.
- 4. Project makes a significant contribution, which is clearly stated and supported.
- 5. Project is clearly contextualized both historically and geographically (i.e., demonstrates extensive knowledge of the historical period of study and the geo-political specificities of the project).
