2021 Guidelines

Application deadline: All materials are due Friday, June 4, 2021. Awards will be announced by August 2021.

Award: \$500 prize

Eligibility: Ph.D. awarded by a University of Miami Humanities Department in 2020-21 (December 2020 or May 2021). Note that August 2020 graduates can also be considered.

Requirements: Please submit a <u>letter of nomination</u> (typically written by the dissertation adviser/director) along with an electronic <u>copy of the entire dissertation</u>, a <u>file with the introduction</u>, and a final <u>file with the abstract</u> to: <u>humanities@miami.edu</u>. The awardee will be requested to deposit a bound copy of the dissertation at the Humanities Center.

Criteria: 1. Dissertation has a wide, interdisciplinary, humanistic appeal.

- 2. Dissertation is well written (i.e., avoids jargon or, if it uses specialized language, it carefully explains all terms used).
- 3. Introduction is well organized and solidly argued.
- 4. Project makes a significant contribution, which is clearly stated and supported.
- 5. Project is clearly contextualized both historically and geographically (i.e., demonstrates extensive knowledge of the historical period of study and the geopolitical specificities of the project).
